Rock Rose Foundation is a private family foundation established in January 2022.

Rock Rose Foundation is a privately funded family foundation started in 2022 by Michael and Solange Hommel in collaboration with Kelsey Hunt. The purpose of this foundation is to support small-scale, local organizations in exploring and alleviating the root causes of inequality and disenfranchisement. These root causes, as identified by the co-founders, include (but are not limited to) access to food, housing, education, healthcare and community building. Along with a focus on these root issues, Rock Rose Foundation prioritizes funding new, small, or non-traditional programs that might face barriers in accessing other funding - with a focus on sustainability, originality, impact, and diversity. Rock Rose Foundation was named after the native Texas flower, the rock rose, that flourishes in a harsh environment, is often used to ease erosion, and spreads enthusiastically.

As an organization, we seek to recognize and address the deeply entrenched practices, cultural norms, and decision making structures that perpetuate inequities. As a new organization, Rock Rose Foundation has experienced a lot of growth in recent years.

In our pilot year, 2022, we received 11 applications and gave 8 grants totalling \$38,400. By 2024, we were able to give a total of \$217,400 to 25 of our 37 applicants during our regular grant cycle. Grant sizes generally range from \$2,000 to \$20,000 dollars, depending on the needs and abilities of the program. Our partner organizations come from all over Bell County, and cover a wide range of community needs.

Rock Rose grant recipients have helped provide vision screening, assistance with prescription medications, and kidney health screening. They've developed education and mentorship programs for local youth, both in and out of the school setting, to support reading, entrepreneurship, and cultural awareness. They run programs for foster children, veterans, individuals in hospice care, and adults with disabilities, as well as individuals dealing with homelessness, substance dependence, and a variety of mental or physical health challenges. They create safe and nurturing spaces for people across all of life's spectrums.
